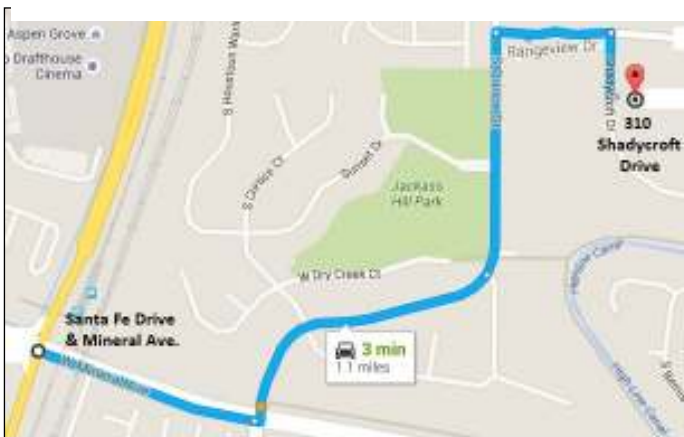

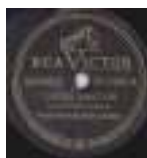
Hot Jazz, Pop Jazz, Hokum, Hilarity and History

On our club session date of July 18, Jelly Roll Morton recorded piano solos of Grandpa's Spells, Kansas City Stomps, Wolverine Blues and The Pearls, in 1923.

And trumpeter Erskine Hawkins' Big Band made the first recording of Tuxedo Junction in 1939.



August 15, 1903, is the birthday of New Orleans drummer Monk Hazel, who also played cornet. He passed away in 1968.



Local favorite Morey Feld, the drummer, was born in Cleveland August 15, 1915; he died in a house fire here in metro Denver in 1971.
