- The UCD Claim Jumpers open the afternoon at 1:00 PM.

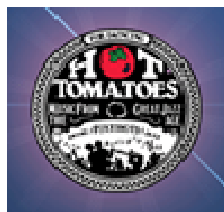
## Annual Ron Cope Rent Party Fundraiser with the Hot Tomatoes, DJC Youth All-Stars and UCD Claim Jumpers

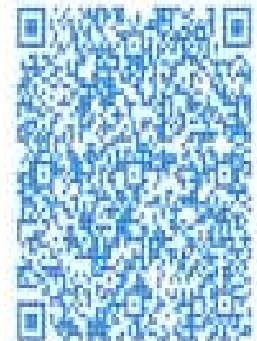

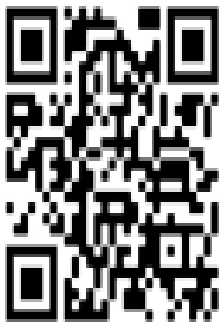
