The Poudre River Irregulars are a colorful jazz ensemble that plays New Orleans and Dixieland jazz, and they are noted for their exuberant energy and sound musicianship. Led by trombonist Lenny Kellogg, they include Larry Lagerberg and/or Charlie Smith, trumpet; Clark Burnside, clarinet; Ray Leake, piano; Rory Thomas, banjo; Alan Sparks, bass; and Oscar DeZoto, drums. Drawing much of their inspiration from the music of Louis Armstrong and Jelly Roll Morton, they play a wide variety of traditional jazz, from ragtime through the classics of the

twenties and thirties up to early swing. Whatever they play, their music is always upbeat and joyful!
