Remembering Dan Simons and Jim Borzym

As many of you will have heard, our Denver Jazz Club board president, Dan Simons, passed away shortly before the Christmas holiday. The cause was complications arising from an infection, coupled with a stroke. Dan had been on the board of directors for the Evergreen Jazz Festival, and was a longtime volunteer for the festival. Among many accomplishments on behalf of the festival, he was responsible for configuring the parking lot at the Evergreen Elks Lodge to accommodate as many vehicles as possible. He had been an engineer at Coors, and was a lifelong jazz enthusiast. A memorial will be planned for later in the year, in warmer weather, and we hope to have more information as the time approaches. Dan was 79 years old. Our sincere condolences to his wife Sandi and his family members. He will certainly be missed.



Our dance enthusiasts will be saddened to learn that Jim Borzym, who organized dances at the Avalon Ballroom in Boulder and was well-known to a lot of bands and dancers, passed away December 14. He had been in ill health due to liver disease. The dance community is saddened by his passing but will work to keep his dance events going, including the New Year's Eve dance at the Avalon with After Midnight. The Wednesday dance events have been transferred to other parties to continue to operate, and Denver Jazz Club member Kurt Reisser acts as DJ once a month for those dances.
