Pianist **Scott Grove** will be joined by **Clint Dadian**, guitar; **Jill Frederickson**, drums; and **Bill McCrossen**, bass. Their repertoire covers the Great American Songbook, jazz standards, and some musical surprises!

Scott Grove was the pianist for the Allan Frederickson Jazz Ensemble, the Summit Hot Seven, and Marti Henry's Jazz Over Easy. He has played duo sets with Mr. David Booker, and plays plenty of local gigs. Clint Dadian is an inventive guitarist, Bill McCrossen provides solid bass work, and Jill Frederickson is one of the most musical jazz drummers around, but is also attentive to the dance audience.

The student band from the University of Colorado – Denver previously known as the Claim Jumpers – has been renamed the Lynx Jazz Ensemble. They will be joining us to play between sets.
